


Chart representing the Alumni feedback analysis on curriculum for the academic year 2019-2020








Chart showing the Alumini feedback analysis on curriculum for the academic year 2019-2020








Chart representing the Employer/Industry feedback analysis for the academic year 201-2020




Chart showing the employer feedback analysis on curriculum for the academic year 2019-2020








Chart representing the faculty feedback analysis on curriculum for the academic year 2019-2020

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


Chart showing the faculty feedback analysis on curriculum for the academic year 2019-2020

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


Chart representing the Hosteller Feedback analysis on facilities for the academic year 2019-2020




Chart representing the Hosteller Feedback analysis on facilities for the academic year 2019-2020




Chart representing the parent feedback analysis on curriculum for the academic year 2019-2020

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


Chart showing the parents feedback analysis on curriculum for the academic year 2019-2020

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


Chart representing the Parent Feedback analysis on facilities for the academic year 2019-2020

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


Chart representing the Parent Feedback analysis on facilities for the academic year 2019-2020




Chart representing the Student feedback analysis on curriculum for the academic year 2019-2020




Chart showing the students feedback analysis on curriculum for the academic year 2019-2020




Chart representing the feedback on facility analysis for the academic year 2019-2020




Chart showing the students feedback analysis on facilities for the academic year 2019-2020






