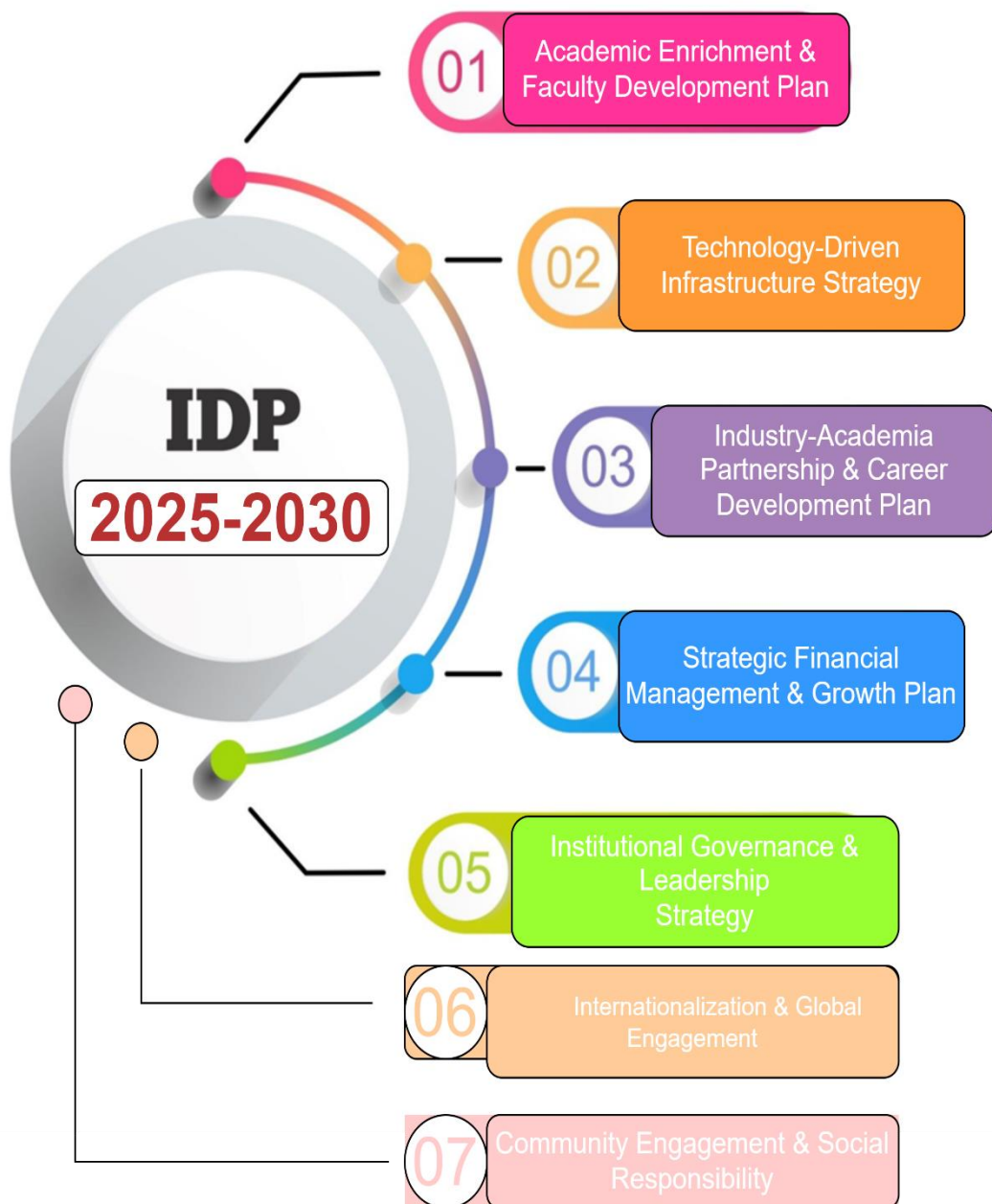
Vision
