ADMISSION POLICY

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to establish clear guidelines regarding admission to various programmes at Kingston Engineering College

Scope

The scope of admission encompasses a wide range of considerations and practices aimed at selecting qualified candidates for admission into engineering programs. The college Counselling assessment was conducted through Anna University as per AICTE norms.

Responsibility

The Management, Principal, and AO/Accounts Manager of Admission are solely responsible for admission.

Admission Process

At Kingston Engineering College, the selection process of candidates for admission inculcates norms as per UG-TNEA (Tamil Nadu Engineering Admissions), PG-TANCET (Tamil Nadu Common Entrance Test), and KNEA (Kingston Engineering Admissions). Our institute follows the procedure of conducting an online or offline entrance examination for selecting students for the Management Quota.

Management Quota

The students are admitted to management quota based on

- ☐ Minimum Eligibility Marks for B.E. / B.Tech Qualifying Examinations and Eligibility
A Pass in the HSC (Academic: both +1 &+2) or its equivalent with a minimum average percentage in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry put together as Percentages
- ☐ Community General Category-45%
- ☐ BC, BCM, MBC&SC/SCA/ST-40%



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Selection Procedure

- Based on the selection, candidates are admitted to the institution. The admission is purely provisional and subject to approval from the Directorate of Technical Education, Chennai/Anna University.

Selection Category

B.E/B.Tech Courses - First Year

- Our college admits all the students under the government quota allotted through single-window counselling by Tamil Nadu Engineering Admission (TNEA).
- Our college admits students under the management quota based on the entrance exam rank list published by the Consortium of Self-Financing Professionals in Tamilnadu.

B.E/B.Tech Courses - Direct Second Year (Lateral Entry)

- Our college admits all students under the government quota allotted through single window counselling by DOTE-Direct II Year (Lateral Entry) Engineering Admissions.
- Our college admits students under management quota based on the overall percentage of marks obtained by a student from the 1st semester to the 6th semester in the full-time Diploma (10+3 / 12+2) examination at degree level or higher secondary level.

M.E/M.Tech, MBA Courses

- PG-Admission is based on the TANCET cut-off marks.
- The student admission is followed by the government quota allotted through single-window counselling by Tamil Nadu Common Admission (TANCA).
- The student admission under the management quota is based on the marks secured in the entrance examination conducted by our institute.

Master of Business Administration (MBA)



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- The student's admission is based on their TANCET marks.

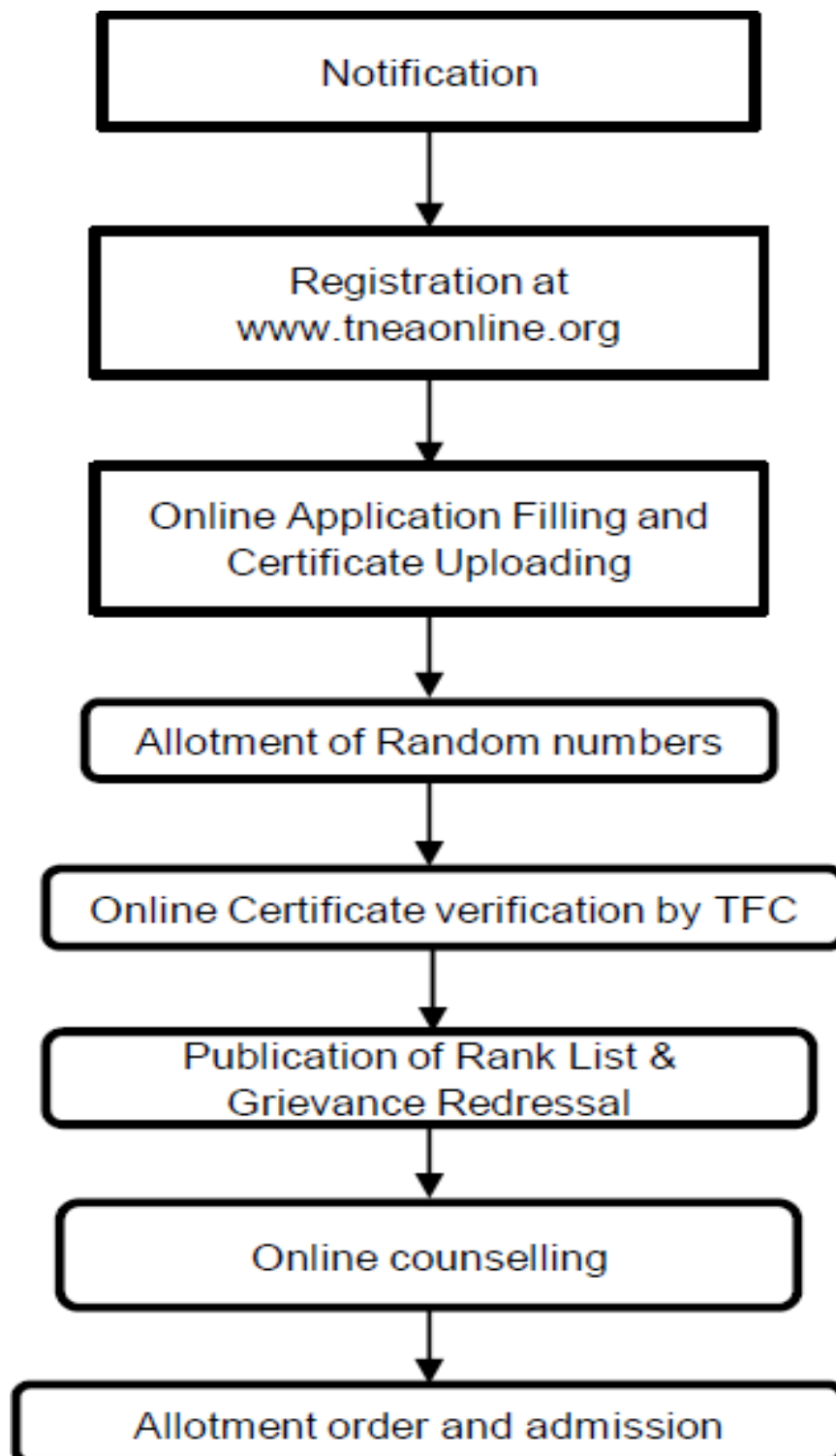

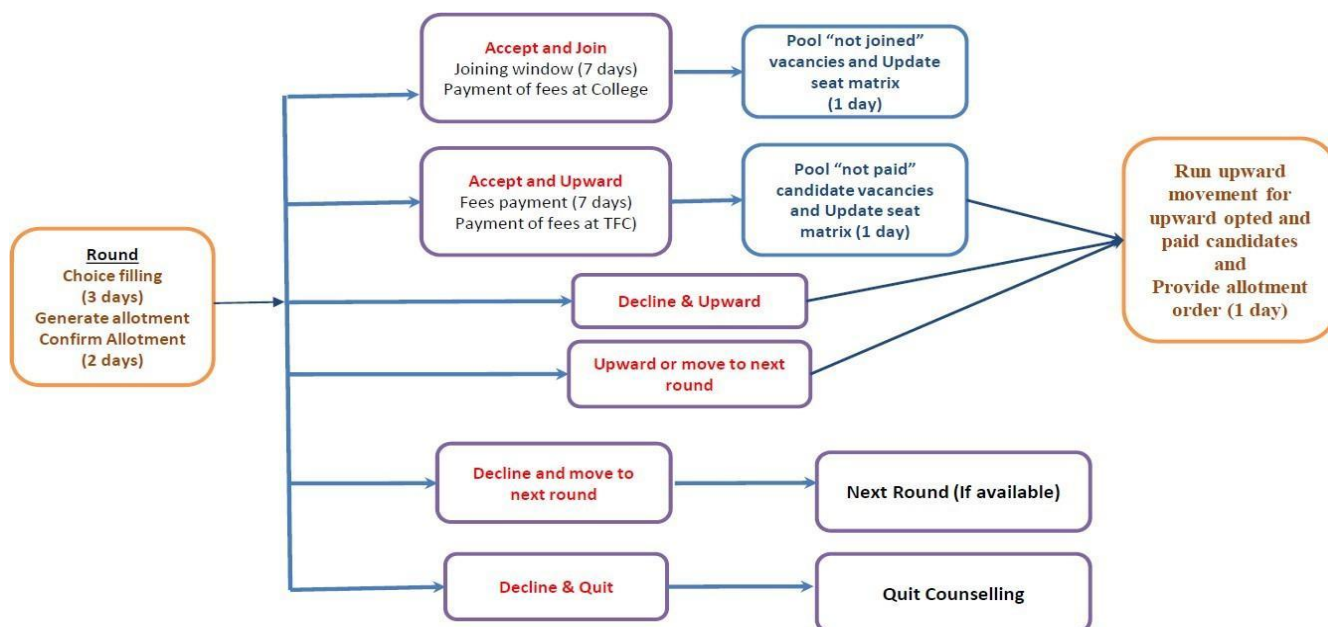

The TNEA counselling procedure of a single round is given below.



The KNEA process is completely specified in the below flowchart representation.

1. Online and offline applications will be scrutinized by the AO/Accounts manager, and the information for the exam will be disseminated through mail/SMS services.
2. The entrance exam schedule and e-hall ticket will be generated, which will be verified on the scheduled day.
3. The exam pattern comprises MCQs, and short answers summing up to 100 marks. Once the evaluation is done, the rank list will be communicated to candidates through mail/SMS. The minimum passing requirement is 45% on the entrance exam.
4. Based on the rank list, candidates will be informed to submit their willingness letter and initial registration fees of Rs. 5,000 towards confirmation for the same.
5. If candidates are declined after confirmation, waiting list candidates will be given preference to fill the lapsed seats. Also, the registration fees will be reimbursed to the candidates.
6. Finally, the management quota student list and all necessary documents will be sent to DOTE for approval and further processing.
