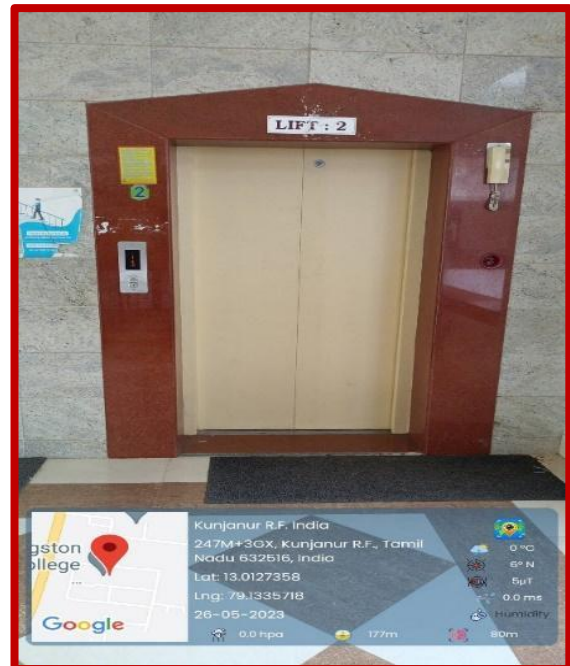
1. DISABLED -FRIENDLY, BARRIER-FREE ENVIRONMENT - LIFTS

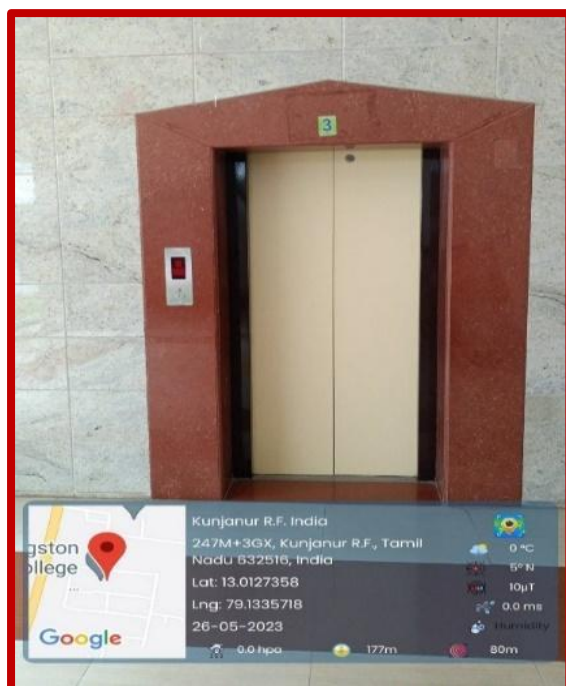

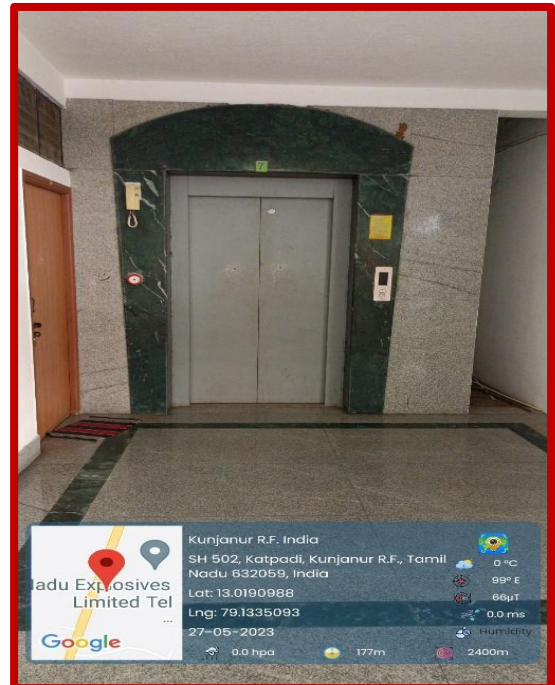

The ramps are provided in both sides of the entrance of the academic block in our college campus which is useful for disabled students. The front-facing gateway of our institution building has a low-angle ramp, a kind of barrier or obstruction for easier access for disabled persons. There are ramps located all over the campus for hard-to-reach areas which will provide a comfortable path for the disabled persons to travel and provide them a good experience. The ramps have been neatly laid out in tiles and marbles which in form of uncontrollable to travel in a wheelchair.

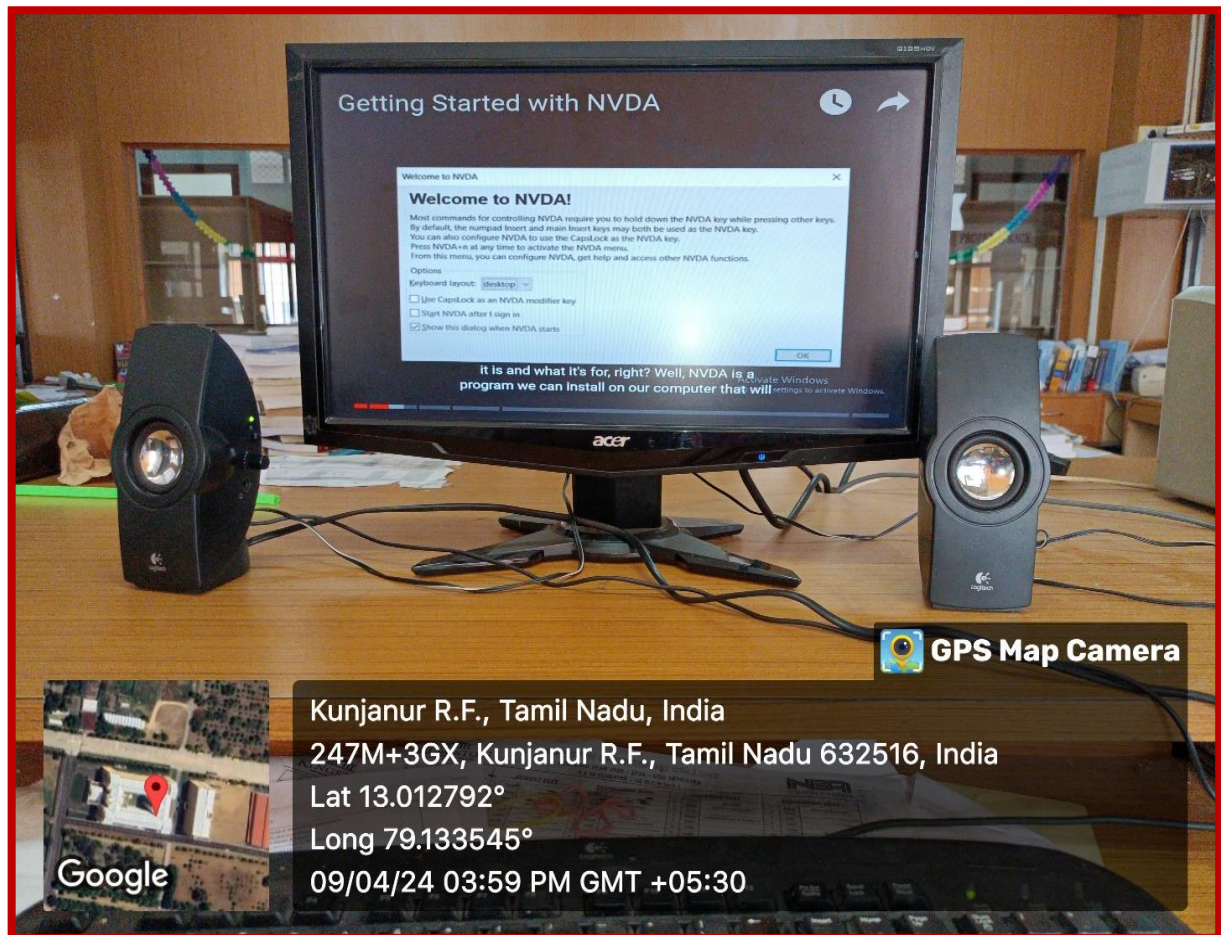


Wheel Chair at Academic Block

NVDA SOFTWARE

Non-Visual Desktop Access software (NVDA) is available in our college Library for disabled students which is an open-source screen reader designed to assist blind and visually impaired individuals in accessing computers. NVDA enables students with visual impairments to participate in virtual classes, online lectures, webinars, and video conferencing platforms by providing access to the visual content through speech or braille output. This allows students to follow along with presentations, interact with instructors, and engage in discussions with classmates.
